On February 20th, the Bay Area's regional housing and transportation agencies, in collaboration with the 6 Wins for Social Equity Network, will hold a Regional Housing and Displacement Forum to discuss the root causes of displacement and solutions to the Bay Area's housing crisis.

Share your story and solutions. Make sure your elected officials understand how the lack of affordable housing and tenant protections affects real Bay Area residents every day – and what they can do about it. This is an opportunity for community members to hold decision-makers accountable for taking real action to address the housing crisis.

Billions of dollars are at stake. The Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) is a public agency made up of locally appointed representatives that distributes billions in transportation funds throughout the Bay Area. Tell MTC that in order to receive this money, cities must have anti-displacement and affordable housing policies in place.
