Cont'd from page 2: we filed a complaint against the San Bernardino County Office of Education for failing to prevent these practices. At the state level, we advocated to close loopholes that allow school districts to unlawfully carry over unspent funds for high-need students and use them for other purposes, such as school policing, and we won a ruling by the California Department of Education against the Los Angeles Unified School District for failing to adequately report and justify its use of \$1.1 billion of funding for these students. A new teacher data system that we advocated for will identify the disproportionate assignment of unprepared teachers in schools with high-need students, and we are working to ensure this data is included in the School Dashboard. We also advocated for teacher credential reforms to remove barriers to a more diverse educator workforce. Following school closures in March, we led efforts to ensure that emergency funds were distributed equitably to support students with the greatest needs and to establish standards for distance learning, addressing learning loss, and providing students social-emotional support. We won a new requirement to provide digital devices and Internet connection to all students. In school districts across the state, we supported families, students, and stakeholders as they advocated for their priorities in district budgeting and decision-making. Our trainings reached 1,845 individuals. Our Higher Education Team is working to ensure that the new Cradle-to-Career data system responds to the needs of students and families; provides data to identify and correct disparities in

college preparation, access, and success; and fosters institutional accountability. Working with community college students, we are advocating for the full implementation of California's remedial education reforms to ensure that students can graduate on time without burdensome debt.

Cont'd from page 2: to ensure that the development of a new ballpark complex includes affordable housing, displacement protections, and living wage jobs. In Oakland and Concord, we provided legal support for community organizations fighting to make sure their cities follow the requirements of the Surplus Land Act to prioritize the use of surplus land for affordable housing. We are advancing the implementation of AB 686, a law we co-sponsored to require public agencies to affirmatively further fair housing, and we are co-leading advocacy to ensure that the Bay Area's regional planning agency requires cities and counties to create a fair sharing of affordable housing. At the local and state level, we are advocating for innovative solutions to the housing crisis that provide tenants and non-profit groups the opportunity to purchase rental properties before they are sold on the open market. Following the COVID-19 state of emergency, we pressed for a statewide moratorium on evictions to protect renters impacted by the epidemic and co-sponsored legislation to extend those protections when the moratorium expired. With the Voices for Public Transit Coalition, we pushed Bay Area transit agencies to adopt safety protections for transit workers and riders. Our national initiative, the Alliance for Housing Justice, brings together housing organizing networks across the country to coordinate and align affordable housing advocacy. The Alliance spearheaded national campaigns to oppose efforts by HUD and the administration to undermine civil rights and fair housing laws.
